February 11-12, 2012 Cross Country Ski Trip Raccoon Run Winter Sports Center, Findlay, Ohio

Be a part of the first Troop 6 overnight ski trip in several years. This year's ski trip is to Raccoon Run Winter Sports Center near Findlay, Ohio, approximately 160 miles away. Since driving time is less than three hours, we will leave the Pleasant Ridge Presbyterian Church **at 7:30 a.m. on Saturday morning, February 11 and return after breakfast on Sunday, February 12.** We will stay Saturday night, February 11 in a rustic cabin at Camp Berry Boy Scout Camp. **The estimated cost of this trip is \$45 per person, including equipment rental. (\$25 if you have your own skis, boots, poles)**

Location. Raccoon Run is located at Riverbend Recreation Area, 16618 Twp. Rd. 208 outside Findlay, Ohio. By leaving at early, we should arrive at Raccoon Run before the ski shop opens at 11:00 a.m., ready for an afternoon of cross-country skiing. The ski rental shop closes at 5 p.m. There are several trails available for our use. **Please note that the trip is weather dependent.
